1-

Jesus invited His disciples into ministry

Jesus called His disciples to be a part of His ministry by commanding them to go out and make disciples.

2-

Jesus equipped His disciples

Jesus equipped His disciples to go out and do ministry.

3-

Jesus taught His disciples

Jesus taught His disciples how to understand the Word of God and interpret it.

4-

Jesus called His disciples to sacrifice

Jesus called on His disciples to give up this life and everything it contained to follow Him.

5-

Jesus modeled sacrifice

Jesus lived out an active example of humble sacrifice and obedience to God the Father before His disciples so that they would have an example to follow.

6-

Kingdom focused

Jesus taught His disciples to be Kingdom-focused in all their actions.

7-

Send them out

Jesus sent out His disciples to do ministry.

Let's sum it up!

- Call your small group to make disciples.
- Remind your small group that they have the power of the Holy Spirit in their lives.
- Teach your small group how to understand and interpret the Word of God.
- Call your disciples to live lives of total sacrifice and obedience before God.
